Biometric data – definition

Personal information about an individual's physical or behavioural characteristics that can be used to identify that person; this can include their fingerprints, facial shape, retina and iris patterns, and hand measurements.

The use of biometric data in our trust

The Rise Partnership Trust does not collect, process, or store pupil biometric information, for use in an automated biometric recognition system, or for any other purpose.
